## **RESTORATION APPEAL UPDATE**

*Thank you to those who have already made a donation*

Following some unexpected delays, we now have an updated and comprehensive Conservation Plan for the restoration of St Mary's Anglican Church. This now enables us to proceed with confidence as we prioritize the stages of the project. In general terms the following have been identified in order of priority:

- The prevention of further water damage and rising damp. Replacing the gutters, downpipes and redirecting the water flow at ground level.
- Internal west wall, repairs to rose window and internal cracks.
- Renewal of external flashing to gables in west wall.
- Repairs to internal cracks in south and north walls.
- Replacing external rotten timbers and repairs to WW2 Lynch Gate and bell tower.
- Repainting external and roof surfaces.

We are currently sourcing quotes for each of these jobs and ongoing works, the details of which will be available at our :
